The second part of the drive involves an appeal to current parents. To this end, the Committee will be circulating a brochure shortly, giving finer details of the drive. Donors are encouraged to pledge certain amounts depending on their means and these donor names will be displayed, according to certain criteria, on a special board for prosperity, marking the occasion. I would encourage all our current parents to enter into the spirit and to support this cause, thereby enabling us to turn our dream of an Art & Technology Centre into a reality.
